

Some important winter constellations

If you look at the actual design of Taurus, it is drawn only as the front half of a Bull. Apparently, Taurus swam all the way to Crete, so his back half was under water and invisible.



The Pleiades are one of the jewels of the skies. In a dark location you might be able to see ten stars.

The group actually contains many hundreds. Binoculars will reveal the glories of the group. The Pleiades are moving through a nebulous cloud, which shines by reflecting the light. However, only a photograph reveals this aspect.
